# WELCOME TO GOLDEN

The City of Golden is located just 15 miles west of Denver but is separated from the rest of the metro area by two stunning mesas and is nestled at the base of the Rocky Mountains. Many major highways give drivers easy access to both the city and the mountains, including I-70, C470, U.S. Highway 6 and Highways 58 and 93. The city is located at an elevation of 5,675 feet and it covers 9 square miles, which includes 9 miles of bike lanes and 29 miles of bicycle/pedestrian trails.

# **COORS 150 EVENT VENUES**

The Coors 150 celebrations will take place at 2 different venues, both open to the public and all ages. Please note, based on the location of these venues there will be road closures and reroutes in place. Plan to leave extra time and consider alternate modes of transportation.

- PARFET PARK: 12pm- 6pm
- WASHINGTON AVENUE (between 11<sup>th</sup> Street and 13<sup>th</sup> Street): 1pm-6pm

## HOW TO GET TO THE EVENT

### **BY FOOT**

If you are a local or visitor within a reasonable distance to the event venues, we suggest you walk and enjoy the mountain view on your way to and from Coors 150. Bring a water bottle to refill when you get onsite and stay hydrated.

#### **BY BIKE**

Due to the limited availability of parking in the downtown corridor, we suggest locals and visitors bike into the event. Bike parking will be available in Parfet Park and TBD. Please bring your lock as the event is not responsible for lost or stolen property. If you have some time before or after the event, visit the City of Goldens <u>website</u> to check out the many options for recreational biking around the area.

### **BY BUS**

RTDs <u>Route 17</u> and <u>Route GS</u> busses run right to Jackson and 10<sup>th</sup> Street, just adjacent to the event venues. Check out RTDs website to check current schedules and pickup locations.

### **BY CAR**

If you plan to drive into the Coors 150 event, please plan to carpool with friends and plan extra time to find event parking due to the busy weekend.

### **RIDE SHARE**

Call your local ride share services to get dropped off and picked up rather than driving during this busy time. We suggest being dropped off at the Golden Visitors & Information Center right in the heart of downtown Golden and right between the Washington Avenue and Parfet Park venues.

## **GOLDEN FLEXRIDE**

The <u>Golden FlexRide</u> serves the majority of the city of Golden and offers extended bus service. Similar to a ride share, FlexRide is available to the general public on a first-come, first-served basis. Call 303-299-6000 (option 2) for more information and to schedule your ride in advance.

## PARKING

While parking may be busy, please refer to the City of Goldens <u>Visitor Parking</u> webpage for all city parking locations and prices. Note that availability may vary during this event weekend.




# FREE TWO-HOUR PARKING

- Parking in the Orange Zones indicated on the map is available for only two hours.
- After 5pm you can park in these areas for free and for the evening.
- The black lines on the map indicate the closed venue area where parking is not available, and traffic reroutes will be in place.

# PARKING 2+ HOURS

- If you plan to stay longer than 2 hours between 7am and 5pm, there are convenient parking garages and parking lots close to downtown indicated in BLUE on the map.
- The first 2 hours are free, each additional hour will incur a fee.
- You MUST register your vehicles at the pay station, even if you are planning to stay less than 2 hours.



### ADDITIONAL PARKING NOTES

While street parking is available outside of the noted areas, please be mindful of permit or fee parking from 7am-5pm daily.

### **EV/ALTERNATE FUELING STATIONS**

If you are driving an electric vehicle and need to charge up, please visit the U.S. Department of Energy's <u>website</u> that shows specific locations for your needs.

#### **BY RAIL**

The <u>West Rail Line</u> runs between Denver's Union Station and Golden dropping passengers off at Jefferson County Government Center/Golden Station. Once at the light rail station, you are still about 3 miles from the venue. It's advised to coordinate a ride from a friend or call a ride share vehicle (see Golden FlexRide). You can also take advantage of the '<u>Ore Cart'</u> free transit that picks up at Golden Station. Hop on the Tungsten Route on Saturday running from 7:30am-7:30pm dropping you off in the heart of Downtown. Be sure to check out the schedule online to plan your ride.
